



Seekonk Congregational Church, Mission and Social Action Committee Present: *“Merciful Conversation on Race”*

In an effort to move toward racial reconciliation, the Mission and Social Action Committee is conducting a five week Lenten series called “Merciful Conversation on Race”. This series is designed to enable white people of goodwill to see with new eyes how privilege in this society works. It is a three-step conversation that provides

1. An opportunity for each participant to explore their own stories and biography on their understanding of white privilege using the lens of race.
2. A look at systemic racism and how it perpetuates white privilege
3. An exploration of “allyship” – how white people can participate with people of color in effecting change.

The series will be conducted on Zoom starting Thursday, February 18 from 6:30-8:30 and will continue every Thursday until March 18. The series will be facilitated by two people; one black, one white. Every participant will be provided a Participant’s Manuel with outline of the series as well as supplemental resources provided through Dropbox.

Participants will be asked to contribute \$40 to cover the cost of the series. Scholarship assistance is available for those unable to manage the fee.
